Scholarships Awarded  
for the Year  
1929-30

Through the generosity of friends of Colorado College there is available for many of the most deserving students of the college, in the form of scholarships, prizes and awards of different kinds, a total of almost eleven thousand dollars annually. These funds are administered largely by the faculty Committee on Scholarships. The Henry Strong Scholarships are administered for the Rocky Mountain region by Mrs. Ella Strong Denison of Denver, and awards are made to students in Colorado College by Mrs. Denison in consultation with the Dean of Women; the scholarships of the Woman's Educational Society of Colorado College are administered by the Executive Board of that organization.

During the past year three new scholarships have been given to the College for student aid. The William C. Dotterer Memorial Scholarship of \$2,500 by an anonymous donor; a scholarship of \$2,000, bearing the donor's name, by Mrs. Augusta D. Swart-Earle; and the Quackenbush Scholarship of \$2,000 by Mr. and Mrs. W. D. Quackenbush. The income from these funds is available to aid deserving students for the first time next year.

These scholarships are the means by which some of the best students are enabled to enter college and to continue their studies in college. Even with these generous sums the Committee on Scholarships is never able to give financial assistance to all of the worthy students who apply for aid.
